

- 1) 13<sup>th</sup> Annual Wreck Beach Bare Buns Run and Buns-Across-the Border Event- Sunday, July 5, 10:30 Sharp. Registration begins on the beach at 8:30 a.m.
- 2) Guinness Book of World Records being attempted for the largest simultaneous skinnydip in North America at noon on July 11<sup>th</sup>. We are having it officially witnessed. People need to come by 10 a.m. to ensure they have signed up before they go into the water right at noon for our official photograph and for the official witnesses to verify. The two official witnesses must sign off on each of our sign up sheets.
- 3) 28<sup>th</sup> Annual Wreck Beach Day and Sandcastle Event is July 19<sup>th</sup> with a cloud and/or rain date set for July 26<sup>th</sup>. This will also be our Second Annual Body Acceptance Day with the BAM Machine (Body Acceptance Machine) and free naked passports to everyone going into the BAM machine and coming out naked!)



In 2005 the Gas Up to Give™ program was introduced. With the use of a card or gift certificate as payment, a portion of the card's value is donated by the grocery & gas retailer to the participating charity or nonprofit organization. Donated funds continue to accumulate to your organization with the ongoing participation of your enrolled card/certificate holders. Over the course of a calendar year, the funds raised can accumulate to significant levels. Also, The Eat to Give™ & Gas Up to Give™ programs are designed to continue calendar year after calendar year.

## GET THOSE 50-50 and END-of-2009-SUMMER RAFFLE TIX WHILE THEY'RE HOT!

Many thanks to all of you who purchased raffle tix and to those of you who donated some of your winnings back as well as to those of you who put the WBPS name on your tix in case you won. Due to physical limitations, Judy is not able to walk the beach as often as she would like and so would appreciate help on our fundraising days where everyone is a winner. A common question we get asked is why do you need money? Well, this newsletter is distributed free of charge but it costs us hundreds of dollars a summer to produce it seasonally. We also have computer expenses and other office expenses with no rent overhead because we operate out of Judy's home "office." We occasionally must hire consultants and incur expenses when we must run off photocopies of briefs we present throughout the year to keep our beach undeveloped. Miscellaneous expenses also crop up such as the BAM machine, Body Acceptance Day and the Naked Passports which are handed out free to naked people to encourage more nudity and less body shame. And, phone expenses also add up monthly, so your monies from raffles, sales of postcards and posters, and fundraisers all add up. For example, we now have a new supply of Uwe Meyer helicopter posters for \$20 each while the supplies last as well as two of his smaller ones for \$10 each titled "The Aerobics Team," and "The Sax Player at Sunset," Judy's personal favourite poster. "It epitomizes the mellow and beautiful side of Wreck Beach at sunset," she said. In addition we have an overflow of shirts from back runs as well as the bum-breast shirts that only go for \$15!!
